between 31st March and 22nd April.

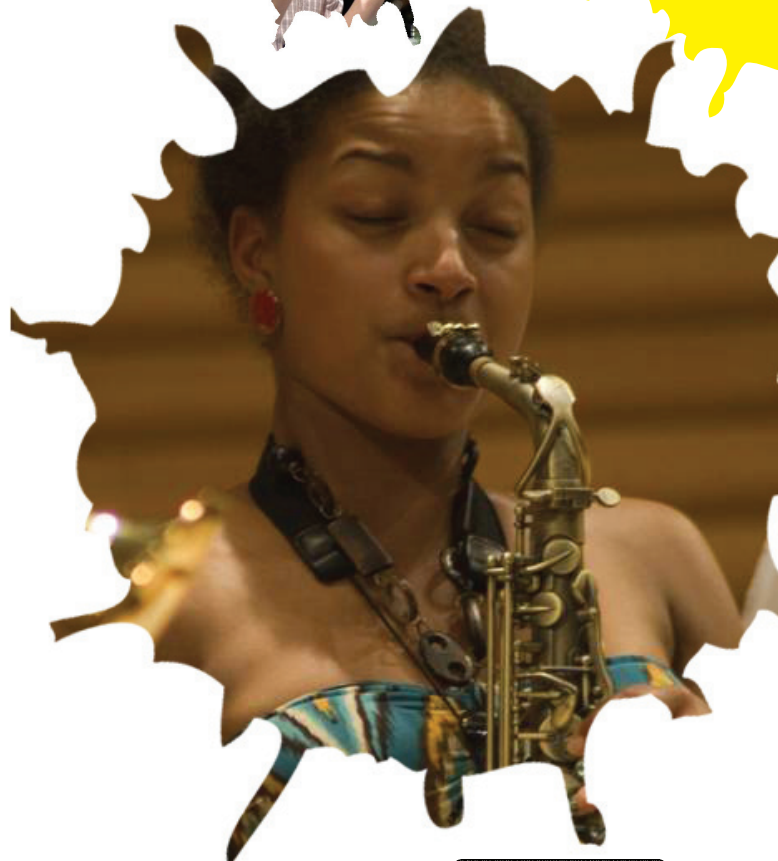
